IMPORTANT INFORMATION


- All people must sign a liability waiver upon entering our park and abide by all rules and regulations.
- All people and vehicles must register at office BEFORE entering campground.
- Pets to be on a leash at all times. No excessive noise or barking. Pets not to be left unattended at any time and not allowed in office/store. Pets must be approved prior to reservation and pet fees will apply (Pet fees for Vacation Rentals only. See below). Vicious and loud dogs are not permitted.
- Please NO boats or boat trailers are allowed at your campsite, rented RV, suites or cottage.
 Boat and boat trailers are to be parked in parking lot at shore when not in use and left there for the duration of your stay.
- Quiet hours are from 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM No excessive noise from people, radios or animals.
 Please be considerate of your neighbours.
- Visitors must register at office before entering and leave by 11:00 PM.
 Daytime visitor fees are \$7/adult, \$3.50/child. Maximum 6 visitors per campsite.
- Please leave your accommodations, boats and campsites as they were provided to you.
- Please no outside firewood allowed (help us protect our trees).

CAMPING AND RVING

- Check-in time is 2:00 PM-8:00 PM on Day of Arrival, Check-out is 11:00 AM on Day of Departure
- Your nightly rate for a campsite includes 4 people Overnight extra people per site are \$7.00/night/ 8 people maximum at a site.
- Maximum Two vehicles per site \$5/day/vehicle for extra vehicles in designated parking
 1 allowed on site
- Only 1 RV(recreational vehicle) OR 2 tents per site 1 small dining tent is also allowed.
- No alcohol or cannabis permitted other than on a campsite.
- All recycling and garbage to be placed in containers near office, beside grey building.
- Dump Station we have an assisted pump-out station to handle your RV waste waters.
 Dumping/Pumping must be done within Open Office Hours.
- On-Site Pump-outs are available for a fee and must be scheduled 24 hours in advance.
- Please keep washrooms tidy no washing of clothes or dishes in washrooms.
- Fire pits are not to be moved without permission no burning of pallets allowed. Please do not leave garbage in fire pits.
- Fires must be supervised at all times by an adult and thoroughly put out with water.
- Please do not attach clothes lines to our trees.
- No fireworks at any time.
- No firearms shall be kept or discharged within any part of the campground.
- No smoking in washrooms, store/office, playground area or docks.
- No washing of RV's, trailers, boats or vehicles allowed at any time.
- No racing or reckless driving of any sort will be tolerated. 10 km/h speed limit at anytime.
- Fish cleaning and fish waste to be done/deposited at fish cleaning station at rental boat dock area.
- Please keep campground clean and safe.

Welcome Boaters and Anglers Please help us make your boating experience more enjoyable:

- Use of Docks, Harbour and launch ramp is at your own risk.
 County Shores is NOT responsible for injury or damage to persons or equipment using our facility.
- All boats and persons using this facility must be registered at the office prior to use. Liability Waivers MUST be completed prior to use.
- All boaters and anglers are responsible for launching and removing their own boat from the water.
- County Shores offers assisted launching for a fee but must be done during office hours.
- Please Park your vehicle in the vehicle parking lot area. Vehicles are not allowed to park on pier area. Please keep vehicles and boat trailers on gravel areas only and not on grass. Please Park boats and trailers in boat parking area.
- Numbered docking is assigned by the office, please do not use numbered docks unless you have registered and paid for one.
- RED LINE docks are for temporary use and are available on a first come first serve basis. Reserving or holding of RED LINE docks is not permitted.
- BLUE LINE docks are for launching and recovery of boats. Maximum 10-minute mooring time only permitted. Please respect those waiting by launching and retrieving your boat quickly.
- Boat motors should be trimmed up while in the harbour area to reduce the risk of prop damage. County Shores is NOT responsible for damaged props.
- All boats MUST be tied with TWO LINES to the Dock Cleats provided and BOAT BUMPERS USED. DOCK RINGS are for BUMPER use only.
- No Sail Boats are allowed in harbour or on docks at anytime.
- All FISH CLEANING is to be done at CLEANING STATIONS.
- BOATS AND BOAT TRAILERS are NOT be on ANY CAMPSITES OR VACATION RENTALS at any time. Please use designated parking area at shore.
- Perimeter of harbour is marked with red and green buoys.
 Stay between buoys and pier to stay in the dredged harbour area.
- All boats exiting or entering harbour must do so between the Green and Red Buoys.
- Harbour Area is a NO WAKE Zone.
- Fishing is permitted off our shoreline and pier. Please be respectful of boats coming into the harbour.
- The Dock and Pier area is not a play area for kids.
- Shore Power \$7/day
