GUIDELINES FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY & ENJOYMENT OF THE PARK

We appreciate your cooperation in observing the following rules and guidelines to ensure a relaxing and enjoyable stay for all our guests. Please feel free to approach the management with any concerns. We will do everything possible to make your stay with us an enjoyable experience.

Check-In Time is 2:00 PM-8:00 PM on Day of Arrival

Check-Out Time is by 11:00 AM on Day of Departure

Liability Waivers – Everyone must complete and sign a liability waiver upon entering our park.

Register at Office First – All people and vehicles must register at office BEFORE entering campground. Once registered, you can come and go as you wish.

Visitors – Visitors must register at office BEFORE entering the park and leave by 10:00 PM. Daytime visitor fees will apply. Maximum 6 visitors per campsite.

Pets are Welcome – Pets to be on a leash at all times. Excessive noise or barking is not permitted. Pets are not to be left unattended at any time and not allowed in office/store. Pets must be registered at check-in. Sorry, no pets permitted in Vacation Rentals. Vicious and loud dogs are not permitted and will be required to be removed from the park without refund.

Boats and Boat Trailers – Boats and boat trailers are **NOT ALLOWED at your campsite**, rented RV, suite or cottage. Boat and boat trailers are to be parked in parking lot at shore when not in use and left there for the duration of your stay.

Quiet Hours – 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM – Please turn your radio and televisions off. No loud talking or any excessive noise from vehicles, pets or camping equipment. Please be considerate of your fellow campers and our neighbours.

Camping Equipment – A campsite is allowed 1 RV unit OR up to 2 sleeping tents. A small dining shelter may be erected on any site. An additional sleeping tent MAY be allowed on a site with an RV but an additional nightly fee will apply.

Vehicles at Campsites – Any combination of two vehicles (Car, Truck or RV) are permitted on a campsite at one time. However, only ever 1 RV is permitted. Additional vehicles, greater than two must pay an extra fee per night and be parked in the designated parking areas.

Campers on a Campsite – Up to 4 Campers per site are included with your campsite fees. Up to 4 additional campers are permitted for an additional nightly fee.

Electric Vehicle Charging Fee - \$20.00/Night. Please arrange at Office before charging.

Campfires and Firepits – Firepits are **NOT to be moved** without permission. Campfires must be supervised at all times by an adult and thoroughly put out with water. Please do not leave garbage in firepits.

Firewood – Please bring only local (Bay of Quinte Area) firewood to the park. Firewood is available for sale at the park store. Help us protect our trees! Burning of pallets or used building materials is NOT allowed.

Alcohol and Cannabis – Consumption or use of alcohol or cannabis is only permitted on your campsite.

Garbage and Recycling – Please leave your campsite, accommodation or boat as they were provided to you. All recycling and garbage are to be placed in containers near office, beside gray maintenance building. Bulk garbage is not permitted.

Dump Station – We have an assisted "pump-out station" to handle your RV waste waters. On your Day of Departure, simply pull up to the pumping station and one of our team members will be there momentarily to assist in draining your tanks. Dump Station is open only within office hours.

On-Site Pump-Outs – Can be arranged at the front office for a fee and must be scheduled 24 hours in advance.

Washrooms and Showers – Open 24 hours per day and located to the rear of office. No washing of clothes or dishes is permitted in washrooms.

Clothes Lines & Tarps – Please do not attach clothes lines to our trees.

Fireworks – No fireworks at any time.

Water Usage – All tap water is potable and regulated by O. Reg 319/08 Small Drinking Water Systems. Please use as much as you need but do not let facets run without reason. No washing of RV's, trailers, boats or vehicles allowed at any time.

Speed Limit – Please keep your speeds slow. Maximum 10 km/h speed limit at any time.

Fish Cleaning – Fish cleaning is to be done at the fish cleaning area. All fish waste is to be deposited in barrels at fish cleaning station. Please do not put any other garbage or debris in fish waste barrels.

The Owners and County Shores are not responsible for any loss due to fire, accidents, theft or any act beyond their control. This is private property and any guest found destroying or damaging campground property must make total restitution.

GUIDELINES FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY & ENJOYMENT OF THE DOCKS, HARBOUR AND LAUNCHES

We appreciate your cooperation in observing the following rules and guidelines to ensure a relaxing and enjoyable boating and fishing experience for all. Please feel free to approach the management with any concerns.

Liability Waivers – Everyone must sign a liability waiver upon entering our park. Use of docks, harbours and launch ramp is at your own risk. County Shores is NOT responsible for injury or damage to person or equipment using our facility.

Register at Office First – All people, boats and vehicles must register at office BEFORE using docks, harbour and launches. Once you have registered, you can come and go as you wish. For those wishing an early start, prior arrangements can be made by contacting the office.

Boat Launching – All boaters and anglers are responsible for launching and removing their own boat from the water. County Shores offers assisted launching for an additional fee but must be done during office hours.

Parking for Docks and Launching – Please park your vehicle and/or boat trailer in the parking lot area adjacent to the docks and harbour. Parking signage is posted showing where different types of vehicles and equipment can be parking. Please keep vehicles and boat trailers on gravel areas only and not on grass. Vehicles are not allowed to park on pier area.

Boats and Boat Trailers – Boats and boat trailers are NOT ALLOWED at your campsite, rented RV, suite or cottage. Boat and boat trailers are to be parked in parking lot at shore when not in use and left there for the duration of your stay.

Numbered Dock Slips – Numbered dock slips are assigned by the office. Please do not moor in a numbered dock unless you have registered and paid for one.

Red and Green Harbour Buoys – Red and Green Harbour Buoys mark the perimeter of our dredged harbour. When navigating the harbour, stay between the buoys and the shore and enter and exit the harbour between the green and red buoys off the end of the main pier.

Blue Line docks are for launching and recovery of boats. Maximum 10-minute mooring time only permitted. Please respect those waiting by launching and retrieving your boat quickly.

Trim Motors – Boat motors should be trimmed up while in the harbour area to reduce the risk of prop damage. County Shores is NOT responsible for damaged props.

Two Lines and Bumpers – All boats MUST be tied with TWO LINES to the dock cleats provided and BOAT BUMPERS USED. DOCK RINGS are for BUMPER use only.

Shore Power – Shore power is available for a nightly fee. Please arrange payment at office before using. You must provide your own power cords.

Sail Boats – Harbour water depth is not adequate for sail boat use.

No Wake – Our Harbour Area is a NO WAKE Zone.

Fishing – Fishing is permitted off our shoreline and pier. Please be respectful of boats coming into the harbour. Boats have the right of way.
